

GOVERNMENT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

ORDERED:

That after public notice and hearing as prescribed by law, the following districts heretofore established by the Zoning Commission of the District of Columbia, as shown in the official Zoning Map and Atlases, are hereby modified and amended as follows:

The C-3-B District in Square 114 is extended to include all property in said square bounded by 20th Street, O Street, P Street, and New Hampshire Avenue, N.W. (66-19)

The R-5-D District located on the north side L Street, Square 51, is extended to include lots 5, 803 to 810 inclusive, Square 51, said property located on the northeast corner of 23rd and L Streets and the east side of 23rd Street between L and M Streets, N.W. (66-63)

All of the east-west 30 foot wide public alley, closed in Sq. 157, except for the east 20 feet of said alley, is included in the SP District, and the north-south 12 foot wide public alley closed and the remainder of the above 30 foot alley closed in Square 157 are included in the R-5-D District. The above alleys were closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 149, pg. 119, Records of the Surveyor, D. C. (S.O. 63-76)

That portion of New York Ave., N.E. closed, abutting parcel 143/53 and lot 809, Square 4102, which was closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 149, pg. 140, records of the Surveyor, D. C. is included in the M District. (S.O. 63-194)

Brandywine Street closed east of 1st Street, S.E. which was closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 150, pg. 101, records of the Surveyor, D. C., is included in the R-5-A District. (S.O. 65-291)

13th Street closed from Bruce Pl. to Stanton Rd., S.E. which was closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 150, pg. 12, records of the Surveyor, D. C. is included in the R-5-A District. (S.O. 64-493)


The three foot wide public alley in Square 565 which was closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 150, pg. 4, records of the Surveyor, D. C. is included in C-3-B District. (S.O. 66-37)

The ten foot wide public alley in Square 283 which was closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 149, pg. 95, records of the Surveyor, D. C. is included in the SP District. (S.O. 64-517)


