ORDERED:

That after public notice and hearing as prescribed by law, the following districts heretofore established by the Zoning Commission of the District of Columbia, as shown in the official Zoning Map and atlases, are hereby modified and amended as follows:

The public alleys closed in Square 3000 which were closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 149, pg. 72, records of the Surveyor, D. C. are included in the R-3 District. (S.O. 65-132)


The public alleys closed in Square 6157 which were closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 133, pg. 27, records of the Surveyor, D. C. are included in the R-5-A District. (S.O. 65-239)

The public alley closed in Square 5173 abutting lots 54, 53, 52, and 68 which were closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 149, pg. 71, records of the Surveyor, D. C. is included in the R-2 District. (S.O. 65-19)


The north half of public alley closed in Square 75 abutting lots 852, 836 and 835 is included in the C-3-B District and the remainder of said closed alley is included in the R-5-C District. The above alley was closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 149, pg. 70, records of the Surveyor, D. C. (S.O. 65-54)

That part of public alley closed in Square 51 abutting lots 863, 851, 55, and 800 which was closed by the Commissioners, D. C. and recorded in Book 149, pg. 69, records of the Surveyor, D. C. is included in the R-5-D District. (S.O. 65-128)
