Zoning Commission Order No. 26

January 28, 1971

ORDERED:

That after public notice and hearing as prescribed by law, the following districts established by the Zoning Commission of the District of Columbia as shown in the Official Zoning Map and Atlases are hereby modified and amended as follows:

The following cases are to establish the zoning of a public street or alley which has been closed by the District of Columbia City Council or by the Commissioners of the District of Columbia under authority of the D. C. Code of Laws as amended:
