



Zoning Commission Order No, 52
September 28, 1972


The Zoning Commission of the District of Columbia,
having met in executive session, hereby ORDERS that:

The staff of the Zoning Commission shall issue notice of
a public hearing to be held within 120 days for the
purpose of considering:

- A) The creation of waterfront zone districts.
- B) Text amendments to the M and C-M zoning districts
which would:
 - 1. Add and encourage residential uses,
 - 2. Eliminate certain non-essential and
environmentally hazardous uses,
 - 3. Reduce the floor area ratio for commercial
and office uses.
