BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT



Application No. 12689 of Exxon Company, U.S.A., pursuant to Sub-section 8207.2 of the Zoning Regulations, for a special exception under Paragraph 5102.41 to rebuild a gasoline service station utilizing space formerly occupied by other commercial uses in the C-2-A District at the premises 3825 Alabama Avenue, S.E., (Square 5522, Lot 810).

HEARING DATE: June 28, 1978
DECISION DATE: July 5, 1978

DISPOSITION: The Board granted conditionally, the application by a vote of 3-0 (Charles R. Norris, Chloethiel Woodard Smith and William F. McIntosh to grant; Leonard L. McCants not voting, not having heard the case).

FINAL DATE OF ORDER: September 1, 1978

By Order of June 18, 1980, the Board denied the applicant's request for modification of plans previously approved by the Board, on the grounds that twenty months had elapsed since the final order was issued.
