Capen, pursuant to Paragraph 3207.11 of the Zoning Regulations, for a variance from the use provisions (Section 3104) to use the first floor of the subject premises as an architect's office in an R-4 District at the premises 810 A Street, S. E., (Square 920, Lot 16).
