Application No. 13390 of C and P Building Limited Partnership, pursuant to Sub-section 8207.2 and paragraph 8207.11 of the Zoning Regulations, for a special exception under Paragraph 3101.46 to use the basement, first, second and third floors of the subject premises for the Potomac School of Law and auxiliary services consisting of 235 students and nine teachers and for a variance from the off-street parking requirements (Sub-section 7202.1) in an R-4 District at the premises 629 Constitution Avenue, N.E., (Square 867, Lot 18).
