

terms of the time necessary for reprocessing an application before the Board.

Upon consideration of the applicant's request and the opposition's response thereto, the Board concludes that the refiling of the subject application at any time subsequent to its withdrawal will not be prejudicial to the opposition. Notice of any new application will be given in an identical manner as required in any application filed before the Board, and the applicant and opposition will have ample time to assemble evidence to support their position with regard to the requested special exception. The Chairperson therefore ruled and it is hereby ORDERED that the request to withdraw without prejudice be GRANTED.
