BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT



Application No. 14901, of Progressive National Convention, Inc., pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108.1, for a special exception under Sub-sections 358.1 and 358.8 to increase the capacity of a youth residential care home to forty residents and a staff of twenty-four in the basement through the third floor in an R-5-A District at premises 603 - 50th Street, N.E., (Square 5194, Lot 824).

HEARING DATES: November 30, 1988 and January 18, 1989  
DECISION DATE: January 18, 1989 (Bench Decision)

ORDER

The application was originally scheduled for the public hearing of November 30, 1988. The applicant appeared at that hearing and requested the Board to continue the application in order for him to meet with relevant Government agencies to address the issues and concerns expressed in the record. The Board continued the case until its public hearing of January 18, 1989.

At the public hearing of January 18, 1989, the case was called several times. There was no response from the applicant or any other person representing the applicant. The Board had not received any communication from the applicant that it would not appear at the public hearing.

Upon consideration of the foregoing facts, it is ORDERED that the application is DISMISSED for failure of prosecution.
