Application No. 15296 of Craig and Janet VanGrasstek, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3107.2, for a variance from the allowable lot occupancy requirement (Sub-section 403.2), and a variance to allow an accessory building abutting an alley that does not meet the setback requirement [Paragraph 2300.2(b)] for a detached private garage with storage for a flat in an R-4 District at premises 1318 Independence Avenue, S.E., (Square 1037, Lot 93).

SUMMARY ORDER

The Board duly provided timely notice of public hearing on this application, by publication in the D.C. Register, and by mail to ANC 6B and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site.

The site of the application is located in Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC") 6B. ANC 6B, which is automatically a party to the application, by letter dated May 8, 1990, submitted written issues and concerns in support of the application.

As directed by 11 DCMR 3324.2, the Board has required the applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements which are necessary to establish the case for a variance from the strict application of the requirements of 11 DCMR 2300.2(b) and 403.2. No person or entity appeared at the hearing or otherwise requested to participate as a party in this proceeding. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

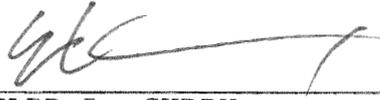
Based upon the record before the Board, the Board concludes that the applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3107, and that the requested relief can be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent, purpose, and integrity of the zone plan as embodied in the Zoning Regulations and maps. It is therefore ORDERED that the application is GRANTED.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR 3301.1, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR 3331.3 that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. The waiver will not prejudice the rights of any party, and is not prohibited by law.
