BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT



Application No. 15394 of Omkar and Angelina O. Agarwal, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3107.2, for a variance to allow an addition to an existing nonconforming structure that does not meet the side yard requirements [Paragraph 2001.3(b) and (c)], a variance from the rear yard requirements (Sub-section 404.1), and a variance from the side yard requirements (Sub-section 405.9) for an addition to a nonconforming single-family dwelling in an R-2 District at premises 3700 Van Ness Street, N.W., (Square 1898, Lot 67).

SUMMARY ORDER

The Board duly provided timely notice of public hearing on this application, by publication in the D.C. Register, and by mail to ANC 3F and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site.

The site of the application is located in Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC") 3F. ANC 3F, which is automatically a party to the application, submitted no written issues and concerns relative to the application.

As directed by 11 DCMR 3324.2, the Board has required the applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements which are necessary to establish the case for a variance from the strict application of the requirements of 11 DCMR 2001.3(b) and (c), 404.1 and 405.9. No person or entity appeared at the public hearing or otherwise requested to participate as a party in opposition to the application or otherwise requested to participate as a party in opposition to this proceeding. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

Based upon the record before the Board, the Board concludes that the applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3107, and that the requested relief can be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent, purpose, and integrity of the zone plan as embodied in the Zoning Regulations and maps. It is therefore ORDERED that the application is GRANTED.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR 3301.1, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR 3331.3 that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. The waiver will not prejudice the rights of any party, and is not prohibited by law.

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
