Dear Chairperson Thornhill:


We request at this time to withdraw from consideration for variance Application No. 15485, proposed accessory garage addition to premises at 3221 Woodland Drive, N.W., Lot 16 in Square 2120, Zoned R-1-A, to allow a two-story accessory garage with a second floor as a dressing room.

This application was initially heard by the Board on April 10, 1991 but was suspended before a vote was taken.
