Application No. 15646 of the Washington Hebrew Congregation, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108.1, for a special exception under Section 206 to expand an existing child development center from 33 to 95 children, ages 2 to 5 years, and a staff from 9 to 24 on the first and second floors in an R-1-B District at premises 3935 Macomb Street, N.W., (Square 1798, Lot 28).

SUMMARY ORDER

The Board duly provided timely notice of public hearing on this application, by publication in the D.C. Register, and by mail to Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3C and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site.

The site of the application is located within the jurisdiction of ANC 3C. ANC 3C, which is automatically a party to this application, submitted issues and concerns by letter dated March 10, 1992 in support of the application.

As directed by 11 DCMR 3324.2, the Board has required the applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements which are necessary to establish the case for a special exception pursuant to 11 DCMR 206. No person or entity appeared at the public hearing in opposition to the application or otherwise requested to participate as a party in opposition to this proceeding. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

Based upon the record before the Board, the Board concludes that the applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108, and that the requested relief can be granted as in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the Zoning Regulations and Map and will not tend to affect adversely the use of neighboring property in accordance with the Zoning Regulations and Map. It is therefore **ORDERED** that the application is **GRANTED**, **SUBJECT** to the following **CONDITIONS**:

1. Approval shall be for a period of FIVE YEARS.
2. The number of students shall not exceed 95, aged two to five years, with a maximum staff of 24.
3. The hours of operation shall be between 7:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.


- 4. A representative of the applicant shall meet with the Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3C no less than once per year in order to assess any problems or concerns of area residents which may arise as a result of the operations of the child development center.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR 3301.1, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR 3331.3 that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. The waiver will not prejudice the rights of any party, and is not prohibited by law.
