BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT



Application No. 15713 of B.A. Schriever and Barbara Schriever Allan, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108.1, for a special exception under Section 205 to continue to operate and to increase the number of children in a child development center from 20 to 23 children ages 2 to 4 years, and three staff on the first floor in an R-1-B District at premises 2828 Hurst Terrace, N.W. (Square 1420, Lot 12).

SUMMARY ORDER

The Board provided timely and proper notice of public hearing on this application by publication in the D.C. Register, and by mail to Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3D and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site.

The site of the application is located within the jurisdiction of ANC 3D. ANC 3D, which is automatically a party to the application, submitted written issues and concerns in support of the application.

As directed by 11 DCMR 3324.2, the Board has required the applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements which are necessary to establish the case for a special exception pursuant to 11 DCMR 205. No person or entity appeared at the public hearing in opposition to the application or otherwise requested to participate as a party in opposition to this proceeding. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

Based upon the record before the Board, the Board concludes that the applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108, and that the requested relief can be granted as in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the Zoning Regulations and Map and will not tend to affect adversely the use of neighboring property in accordance with the Zoning Regulations and Map. It is therefore **ORDERED** that the application is **GRANTED**, **SUBJECT** to the following **CONDITIONS**:

1. Approval shall be for a period of **TEN (10) YEARS**.
2. Enrollment shall be limited to a maximum of twenty-three (23) children.


3. The maximum number of employees shall not exceed three, consisting of one teacher and two aides.
4. The hours of operation shall be between 9:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, during the months of September through May.
5. A staff person shall assist in the discharge and pick-up of children to the facility by escorting the children to and from vehicles and the facility.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR 3301.1, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR 3331.3 that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. The waiver will not prejudice the rights of any party, and is appropriate in this case.

THIS ORDER OF THE BOARD IS VALID FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDER, UNLESS WITHIN SUCH PERIOD AN APPLICATION FOR A BUILDING PERMIT OR CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY IS FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS.

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
