Application No. 16000 of Potomac Foods Co., II, Inc., pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108.1, for a special exception under Section 214 to establish accessory parking in an R-1-B District at premises 4422 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. (Square 1971, Lot 822).

SUMMARY ORDER

The Board provided proper and timely notice of public hearing on this application by publication in the D.C. Register, and by mail to Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3F and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site.

The site of this application is located within the jurisdiction of ANC 3F. ANC 3F, which is automatically a party to this application, submitted a written statement of issues and concerns expressing conditional support for the application.

As directed by 11 DCMR 3324.2, the Board has required the applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements which are necessary to establish the case for a special exception pursuant to 11 DCMR 214. No person or entity appeared at the public hearing in opposition to this application or otherwise requested to participate as a party in this proceeding. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

Based upon the record before the Board, the Board concludes that the applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108, that the requested relief can be granted as being in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the Zoning Regulations and Map. The Board further concludes that granting the requested relief will not tend to affect adversely the use of neighboring property in accordance with the Zoning Regulations and Map. It is therefore **ORDERED** that this application is **GRANTED**, **SUBJECT** to the following **CONDITIONS**:

1. Approval shall be for a period of **FIVE YEARS**.
2. The parking surface, the vegetation and fence along the western boundary of the site shall be maintained in good condition at all times.


3. The applicant shall establish and maintain a liaison with Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3F to ensure the resolution of any objectionable conditions that may arise from time to time in the future due to the operation of the parking lot.
4. The loudspeaker used by the restaurant at 4422 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. shall be maintained at a volume level that does not exceed 70 decibels.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR 3301.1, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR 3331.3 that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. The waiver will not prejudice the rights of any party, and is appropriate in this case.

THIS ORDER OF THE BOARD IS VALID FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS, UNLESS WITHIN SUCH PERIOD AN APPLICATION FOR A BUILDING PERMIT OR CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY IS FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS.
