DISMISSAL ORDER

Application No. 16156 of the District of Columbia Government on behalf of the Greater Washington Boys and Girls Club, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3108.1 for a special exception under Section 209 to establish a youth development and educational activities (community center) in an R-1-B District at premises 1701 Montana Avenue, NE (Square 4122, Lot 836).

DECISION DATE: April 9, 1997

Application No. 16156 was filed with the Board of Zoning Adjustment on April 29, 1996. A request for a waiver of the application fee was filed at the time the application was filed. The request was denied. The applicant was notified of the denial and instructed to submit the appropriate filing fee. As of the date of this Board's decision, the applicant had not paid the fee necessary to continue the processing of the application. No further action was taken by the applicant to either remit the proper filing fee or to proceed with the case. The only reasonable result of the applicant's election not to proceed pursuant to the Board's Rules is the dismissal of the application.

The applicant has left the Board no reasonable alternative other than dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that this application is **DISMISSED** for want of prosecution.
