DISMISSAL ORDER

Application No. 16158 of the District of Columbia Government on behalf of the Greater Washington Boys and Girls Club, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3107.2 for a variance from the use provisions (Subsection 330.5) to establish a youth development and recreation activities office in an R-4 District at premises 1000 12th Street, SE (Square 1023, Lot 122).

DECISION DATE: April 9, 1997

Application No. 16158 was filed with the Board of Zoning Adjustment on April 29, 1996. A request for a waiver of the application fee was filed at the time the application was filed. The request was denied. The applicant was notified of the denial and instructed to submit the appropriate filing fee. As of the date of this Board's decision, the applicant had not paid the fee necessary to continue the processing of the application. No further action was taken by the applicant to either remit the proper filing fee or to proceed with the case. The only reasonable result of the applicant's election not to proceed pursuant to the Board's Rules is the dismissal of the application.


The applicant has left the Board no reasonable alternative other than dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute.
