**Application No. 16367** of Paul Unson, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3107.2 for a variance from Subsection 2001.3(c) to allow an addition to an existing semi-detached single-family dwelling and a variance from Subsection 405.9, the minimum side yard setback requirement for a single-family dwelling in an R-1-A District at premises 4824 Nebraska Avenue, N.W. (Square 1759, Lot Per Subdivision).

**SUMMARY ORDER**

The Board provided proper and timely notice of public hearing on this application by publication in the D.C. Register, and by mail to Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3E and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site.

The site of this application is located within the jurisdiction of ANC 3E. ANC 3E, which is automatically a party to this application did not submit a report or otherwise participate in this application.

As directed by 11 DCMR 3324.2, the Board has required the applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements which are necessary to establish the case for variances from the strict application of the requirements of 11 DCMR 2001.3(c) and 405.9. No person or entity appearing as a party to this case testified in opposition to the application. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

Based upon the record before the Board, the Board concludes that the applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR 3107.2, that there exists an exceptional or extraordinary situation or condition related to the property which creates an undue hardship for the owner in complying with the Zoning Regulations, and that the requested relief can be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent, purpose, and integrity of the zone plan as embodied in the Zoning Regulations and Map. It is therefore **ORDERED** that this application be **GRANTED**.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR 3301.1, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR 3331.3 that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. The waiver will not prejudice the rights of any party, and is appropriate in this case.
