Application No. 16407 of Capitol Hill Group pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3108.1 (new 3104.1) for a special exception under Section 359 for opening an additional 32 beds in an existing nursing facility at 700 Constitution Avenue, N.E. (Square 865, Lot 76).

HEARING DATE: January 6, 1999

DECISION DATE: February 3, 1999

DISPOSITION: The Board granted the application for an additional 32 beds with conditions for an existing nursing facility at 700 Constitution Avenue, N.E. (Square 865, Lot 76) by a vote of 3-0 (Betty King, Sheila Cross Reid, and Jerry Gilreath, to grant).

ORDER VACATING MODIFICATION ORDER

This matter came before the Board of Zoning Adjustment on February 13, 2001, for a rehearing of applicant Capitol Hill Group's request for modification of the Board's Decision and Order dated October 21, 1999. The Board had granted the rehearing upon Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6A's motion for reconsideration of the Board's September 8, 2000, Order on Request for Modification.

The following persons requested party status for purposes of participating in the rehearing: Stanton Park Neighborhood Association, Capitol Hill Coalition for Sensible Development, Edge Advertising, St. James Parish, Douglas A. Bernard, Andrea Jenetta, Gregory C. Frane, Lisa M. Tate and Ragnar U. Thoresen, Gaylea G. Shultz, Ellen Anderson and Robert Lucchesi, Brandon J. Rees, and Albert A. Getz, Jr. and Sara Nieves-Grafals.

On February 12, 2001, the applicant filed a request to withdraw its request for modification. Since the request for modification had already been granted, the Board treated the applicant's request for withdrawal as a request to vacate the modification order. The Board vacated the modification order and removed the rehearing on the request for modification from its public hearing agenda. The Board's Decision and Order dated October 21, 1999, including the conditions to the order, is therefore in full force and effect.

The Board also determined that it was not necessary to rule on the requests for party status, since the Board's order to vacate the modification order mooted the necessity for the rehearing. Under 11 DCMR § 3105.5, the Board may not consider moot questions.


The Board, by consensus, granted the Applicant's request that the modification order be vacated.
