On behalf of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3E, I hereby withdraw Appeal No. 16649, filed September 18, 2000 and supplemented by letter dated October 4, 2000, appealing the administrative decisions of Michael D. Johnson, Zoning Administrator, Building and Land Regulation Administrator, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, made approximately March 18, 1999 (Construction Permit No. B425211) and October 20, 1999 (Construction Permit No. 11644), to permit construction of a television and other telecommunications transmission antenna tower, 756 feet in height, at 4623 - 41st Street, N.W. The appeal is being withdrawn as moot (without prejudice in the event the permits in question were ever reactivated), in light of the official rescission of the permits on October 10, 2000.
