Appeal No. 16679 of Spring Valley – Wesley Heights Citizen’s Association, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3100 and 3101 from the administrative decision of the Zoning Administrator, Zoning Review Branch, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, in the issuance of a building permit (No. B430091) that was issued on October 11, 2000, to Charles A. Sisson for the construction of a partial front porch, rear addition, and accessory garage to an existing dwelling in a WHOD/R-1-A District at premises 3020 43rd Street, N.W. (Square 1621, Lot 70).

ORDER TO CONTINUE PROCEEDINGS

The owner of the property that is the subject of this appeal, Charles A. Sisson, filed a motion with the Board of Zoning Adjustment on August 27, 2001, to dismiss the appeal as moot. The appellant, Spring Valley -- Wesley Heights Citizens’ Association, opposed the motion, and requested the Board to defer further action on this appeal until after the Board had issued its order in BZA Application No. 16521 and the Court of Appeals had rendered its decision on BZA Appeal No. 16405. At its regularly scheduled October 2, 2001, public meeting, the Board scheduled a decision meeting on the motion to dismiss for January 2, 2002. The Board subsequently issued its decision in BZA Application No. 16521.

On December 15, 2001, in his motion to postpone the hearing on this appeal, the owner again requested the Board to dismiss the appeal as moot, but indicated that if the Board were to deny the motion, the Board should postpone the hearing until after the Court of Appeals has rendered its decision on Appeal No. 16405. In response, the appellant requested the Board to summarily grant the appeal or, alternatively, allow the appellant to file its pre-hearing statement after the motion to postpone had been decided.

The Board took up the motions at its January 2, 2002, decision meeting, and decided, pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3105.11 and for reasons of administrative efficiency, to defer action on the owner’s motion to dismiss and to defer the hearing on the appeal, should there be any issues remaining that require hearing, until after the Court of Appeals renders its decision on BZA Appeal No. 16405.

Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the decision meeting on the owner's Motion to Dismiss Appeal as Moot and the public hearing on the appeal are hereby **CONTINUED**, pending receipt by the Office of Zoning of the mandate of the Court of Appeals with respect to BZA Appeal 16405.



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
