Application No. 18120 of Nazmul Haque, pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3104.1, for a special exception to operate a fast food restaurant (Wings To Go) under Section 733, in the Fairfax Village Shopping Center, in the C-2-A District at premises 3835 Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E. (Square 5673, Lot 803).

SUMMARY ORDER

REVIEW BY THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR

The application was accompanied by a memorandum from the Zoning Administrator certifying the required relief.

The Board provided proper and timely notice of the public hearing on this application by publication in the *D.C. Register* and by mail to Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC”) 7B, and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site. The site of this application is located within the jurisdiction of ANC 7B, which is automatically a party to this application. The ANC 7B submitted an e-mail on the same day of the public hearing in support of the application. The Board did not give great weight to the ANC correspondence. The Office of Planning (“OP”) submitted a report recommending against the application.

As directed by 11 DCMR § 3119.2, the Board has required the Applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements that are necessary to establish the case pursuant to § 3104.1, for special exception under section 733. No parties appeared at the public hearing in opposition to this application. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

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Based upon the record before the Board and having given great weight to the OP report, the Board concludes that the Applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3104.1 and 733, that the requested relief can be granted as being in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the Zoning Regulations and Map. The Board further concludes that granting the requested relief will not tend to affect adversely the use of neighboring property in accordance with the Zoning Regulations and Map.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3100.5, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR § 3125.3, that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. It is therefore **ORDERED** that this application be **GRANTED**.
