ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 192

November 17, 1977

At its public meetings on Thursday, November 10, 1977, and Friday, November 11, 1977, the District of Columbia Zoning Commission authorized the scheduling of a public hearing on the following Cases:

77-32

An application from Frank A. O'Neil to amend the D.C. Zoning Map from R-1-B to R-5-A for lots 9, 10, 853, 854 and 855 in square 1356 located on Lingan Road, west of the intersection of MacArthur Blvd., and Foxhall Road, N.W.

77-33

A petition from the Far Northeast Advisory Neighborhood Commission -7C requesting the District of Columbia Zoning Commission to consider amendments to the D.C. Zoning Map for various properties located in and near the right-of-way of the East Washington Railway.

77-36

An application from the D.C. Department of Housing and Community Development to amend the D.C. Zoning Map from R-5-C to C-2-B for lot 25 in square 4325; fronting on Bladensburg Rd., N.E. and located in the Fort Lincoln Urban Renewal Area.

77-37

An application from the Pennsylvania Avenue Development Corporation and the Municipal Planning Office to amend the text of the D.C. Zoning Regulations regarding the implementation of the Pennsylvania Avenue Plan through Zoning as well as other changes to the Commercial Districts primarily C-3-B and C-4.

77-39

An application from the D.C. Department of Housing and Community Development to amend the D.C. Zoning Map from C-2-A and R-4 to C-2-B or, in the alternative, R-5-C for various lots at the western half of square 2855 bounded by 13th, 14th, Girard, and Harvard Streets, N.W., 14th Street Urban Renewal Area.
