ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 196

December 13, 1977

At its public meeting on Thursday, December 8, 1977, the District of Columbia Zoning Commission authorized the scheduling of a public hearing on cases no.:

- 77-30 A petition, initiated by the Neighborhood Housing Service, Inc., the Frederick Douglass Community Improvement Council, and the Fort Stanton Civic Association, requesting the Zoning Commission to amend the D.C. Zoning Map from R-5-A to R-2 and R-3 for several single-family neighborhoods in the Anocostia area, bounded generally by Fort Stanton Park, Suitland Parkway, Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue, and Good Hope Road, S.E. (D.C. Zoning Commission, sponsor)
- 77-38 An application to amend the D.C. Zoning Map from R-1-B to C-1 for lot 857 in square 1440, located near the intersection of MacArthur Blvd., and Cathedral Avenue, N.W. (Marvin and Janet Stein, applicants).
- 77-42 An application to amend the text of the D.C. Zoning Regulations regarding conversions of multiple dwellings to apartment in R-4 Districts. (Capitol Hill Restoration Society, applicant).
- 77-44 Revision of the Rules of Practice and Procedure before the District of Columbia Zoning Commission - Title 20 ( D.C. Zoning Commission, sponsor).
- 77-45 An amendment to the text of the D.C. Zoning Regulations to develop a Diplomatic Zone District (Municipal Planning Office, sponsor).
