ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 225

CASE NO. 77-32

June 9, 1978

The above referenced case is an application for an amendment to the Zoning Map to change from R-1-B to R-5-A property located on the southeast side of Lingan Road, west of the intersection of MacArthur Blvd. and Foxhall Road, N.W., known as lots 9, 10, 853, 859 and 855 in square 1356. This case was heard by the Zoning Commission on January 10, 1978, and by Order No. 217, dated May 11, 1978, the Zoning Commission denied the application. On May 24, 1978, pursuant to Section 2.641 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure before the Zoning Commission of the District of Columbia, the applicant filed a motion for rehearing.

Upon consideration of the motion, and the report of the Municipal Planning Office dated May 29, 1978, the Commission hereby determines that the evidence supporting the application has been sufficiently revised and that the positions of various District government agencies have significantly changed to suggest that a new hearing in the case would be appropriate. It is therefore ordered that a new public hearing on the application be set, and that the case be reheard with notice to be given as in the case of an original hearing.

A formal notice of public hearing will therefore be forthcoming.
