ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 317  
CASE NO's 79-10, 80-2, 80-3 and 80-4  
June 16, 1980

At its public meeting on June 12, 1980, the District of Columbia Zoning Commission authorized the scheduling of a public hearing for the following cases:

79-10 Action initiated by the D.C. Zoning Commission on May 10, 1979 to consider the rezoning of that portion of the Connecticut Avenue frontage between Dupont Circle and Florida Avenue, N.W. By Order No. 307 dated January 11, 1980, the Commission had previously authorized a hearing to consider rezoning from C-3-C to C-3-B. The Commission hereby authorizes a hearing to also consider rezoning from C-3-C to C-2-A or any intervening commercial district category.

80-2 Application from Bernard L. and Gertrude S. Goldenhorn, and Shirley and Jerome Markowitz and Marian and Jack Marks to amend the Zoning Map from R-1-B to C-M-1 or in the alternative, C-2-A for lots 33 and 36 in square 3187. The site is located at 7053 and 7059 Blair Road, N.W., and comprises approximately, 13,100 square feet.

80-3 Action initiated by the D.C. Zoning Commission to consider an amendment to the text and the map of the D.C. & 80-4 Zoning Regulations regarding the creation and mapping of a Hotel Incentive (H) District.

A formal "Notice of Public Hearing" is forthcoming in these cases.
