On May 13, 1985, at its regular monthly meeting, the District of Columbia Zoning Commission authorized the scheduling of a public hearing for the following:

Case No. 85-6

Initiative by the Zoning Commission to consider amendments to the Zoning Regulations concerning the continuation of parking lots in the Special Purpose District. The proposal is intended to allow the continuation of parking lots in SP Districts with the approval of the Board of Zoning Adjustment as a special exception, rather than as a use variance. Alternative language for consideration to achieve this objective will be prepared by the Zoning Secretariat and approved by the Zoning Commission.

It is therefore hereby ordered that the above cited case be scheduled for public hearing. A formal "Notice of Public Hearing" is forthcoming.
