(Reed-Cooke Map Amendment)  
September 8, 1986


At its public meeting on September 8, 1986, the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia authorized the scheduling of a public hearing for the following:

A proposal to amend the Zoning Map of the District of Columbia from C-M-2 to R-5-B for various properties in the Reed-Cooke area of the District of Columbia, which is bounded generally by Columbia Road, Euclid, 16th and 18th Streets, and Florida Avenue, N.W.

Reed-Cooke is designated as a Special Treatment Area in the Land Use Element of the Comprehensive Plan of the District of Columbia, and is defined as the C-M-2 pocket in the Adams-Morgan community. The purpose of the proposal is to gain land use control over future development of the area, and to make the zoning not inconsistent with the Comprehensive Plan.

It is therefore hereby ordered that Z.C. Case No. 86-12 be scheduled for public hearing. The formal "Notice of Public Hearing" appears elsewhere in this issue of the D.C. Register.
