ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 513-R
Case No. 85-3C
(1215 I Street, - PUD)
May 11, 1992

By Z.C. Order No, 513-P, the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia approved the schedule for the production of 11 of 150 housing units that are required by Condition Nos. 9 through 11 of Z.C. Order No. 513.

By letter dated May 4, 1992, Wilkes, Artis, Hedrick & Lane, counsel for the applicant, requested the Commission to modify the number of housing units approved by the schedule for production of units in Z.C. Order 513-P from 11 to 9 housing units. With this change, 147 of the required 150 rehabilitated housing units will be provided for in the schedule for production to date.


On May 11, 1992 at its monthly meeting, the Zoning Commission reviewed the above-referenced letter and decided to grant the request. In consideration of the letter, the proposed schedule, and in light of the provisions of Condition Nos. 9 through 11 of Z.C. Order 513, the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia hereby orders APPROVAL to modify Z.C. Order No. 513-P. The modification approves the schedule of production for 9 housing units instead of 11 as initially approved in Z.C. Order No. 513-P.
