ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 561
Cases No. 87-27, 87-35 and 87-37C
January 11, 1988

At its regular monthly meeting on January 11, 1988, the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia authorized the scheduling of a public hearing for the following:

Case No. 87-27

ANC-3C

Petition initiated by the Cleveland Park Historical Society, the Tenley and Cleveland Park Emergency Committee, the Wisconsin Avenue Corridor Committee, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C, and the Protestant Episcopal Cathedral Foundation requesting the Zoning Commission to rezone the west side of Wisconsin Avenue, N.W. between Idaho Avenue and Massachusetts Avenue, and the east side of Wisconsin Avenue between Quebec Street and Woodley Road.

Case No. 87-35

ANC-8C

Application from Louis Bojan requesting a change of zoning from unzoned property to R-4 for a part of parcel 243/75 located on 4th Street between Trenton Street and Mississippi Avenue, S.E. The site is known as GSA Parcel II and comprises approximately 2.71 acres of land area. The applicant has no specific development Plan at this time; and

Case No. 87-37C

ANC-4A

Application as amended for a consolidated Planned Unit Development (PUD) and Map Amendment from R-1-B to C-2-A or, in the alternative, from C-2-A and R-1-B to C-2-B for lots 8-13, 809-813, and 816 and parcels no. 91/159, 91/160, 91/169, 91/171, 91/172, and 91/173 in Square 2960. The PUD site

is generally bounded by Eastern, Georgia and Alaska Avenues, and Kalmia Road, N.W., and consists of 87,639 square feet of land area.

It is therefore hereby ordered that Z.C. Cases No. 87-27, 87-35, and 87-37C be scheduled for public hearing. A formal "Notice of Public Hearing" for these cases is forthcoming.
