ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 587-A  
CASE NO. 84-10  
(Antennas - Text)  
July 10, 1989

By Zoning Commission Order No. 587, which became final and effective on February 24, 1989, the Zoning Commission approved amendments to Title 11, DCMR, with respect to antennas. Because of a failure to account for previous amendments to Title 11, several amendments referenced the incorrect provision of Title 11. Accordingly, the Commission orders approval of the following technical corrections to Zoning Commission Order No. 587:


1. In amendment numbered 8, Section 211, relating to "ANTENNA, COMMERCIAL BROADCAST (R-1)," is renumbered as Section 212.
2. In amendment numbered 9, Section 212, relating to "ANTENNA, OTHER THAN COMMERCIAL BROADCAST ANTENNA (R-1)," is renumbered as Section 213.
3. Amendment numbered 10 is revised to read as follows:

Renumber existing sections 213 through 221, and all references thereto in Title 11, as sections 214 through 222.
4. In amendment numbered 26, the reference to "sub-sections 211, 212" is amended to read "sections 212, 213."
5. In amendment numbered 29, the reference to sub-section 930.3 is amended to read as 930.2.

For the purpose of providing an unambiguous date for the operation of the foregoing amendments, the Zoning Commission ORDERS that, when this Order becomes final and effective, the amendments that are effected by this order shall operate retroactively, beginning on February 24, 1989.

This Order was approved by the Zoning Commission at the public meeting on July 10, 1989, by a vote of 4-0 (John G. Parsons, Maybelle Taylor Bennett, and Lindsley Williams to approve; George M. White to approve by proxy; and Lloyd D. Smith not voting, not having heard the case).

In accordance with 11 DCMR 3028, this order is final and effective upon publication in the D.C. Register, that is, on \_\_\_\_\_, and upon becoming effective shall operate as ORDERED above.
