ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 678

Case No. 89-25

(Downtown Development District - Affordable Housing)

This over-all case is an initiative of the Zoning Commission resulting from petitions from the D.C. Preservation League, the National Capital Area Chapter of the American Planning Association and the District of Columbia Office of Planning requesting the establishment of a Downtown Historic Preservation District, Downtown Residential District, and Downtown Development District respectively. This phase of Case 89-25 will address the provisions that would govern the provision of off-site affordable housing, in place of required on-site housing.

On October 15, 1990, at its regular monthly meeting, the Zoning Commission decided to hold a public hearing on this phase of the case

It is therefore ordered that Z.C. Case No. 89-25 (Downtown Development District) be scheduled for further public hearing. A "Notice of Public Hearing" for this case appeared in the D.C. Register on October 26, 1990.
