ZONING COMMISSION ORDER NO. 683

Case No. 90-17

(Rezoning Petition - Washington National Cathedral)

December 17, 1990

On December 17, 1990, at its regular monthly meeting, the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia authorized a public hearing on the following case:

Z.C. Case No. 90-17 stems from a petition from Advisory Neighborhood Commission ANC - 3C, the Protestant Episcopal Cathedral Foundation, and the Tenley & Cleveland Park Emergency Committee requesting the Zoning Commission to rezone two discrete areas in the Washington National Cathedral area from R-5-C to R-5-A, to preserve existing low scale heights in the area directly opposite and northwest of the Cathedral. The proposed rezoning would affect portions of Square 1920, which is bounded by Woodley Road, Wisconsin Avenue, Macomb, and 38th Streets, N.W., and Square 1923, which is bounded by Wisconsin and Massachusetts Avenues, 38th Street, and Woodley Road.

It is therefore ordered that Z.C. Case No. 90-17 be scheduled for a public hearing. A formal notice of Public Hearing for this case appears elsewhere in this edition of the D.C. Register.
