On September 14, 1992 at its regular monthly meeting the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia authorized a public hearing for the following:



The Zoning Commission will consider rezoning several properties in the area of the Anacostia Metro Station, which is located on the south side of Howard Road between Firth Sterling Avenue and Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue S.E. The Commission will consider rezoning the properties in Squares 5860, 5861 and 5862 from C-M-1 to W-3, CR, or C-3-A.

By memorandum dated September 4, 1992, the District of Columbia Office of Planning (OP) requested the Zoning Commission to rezone "Subareas C and D" of the Anacostia Metro Station Study Area. The purposes of the rezoning request are to help implement the goals and policy objectives of the Comprehensive Plan for the National Capital, and to help stimulate economic growth and development near the Metrorail Station.

It is therefore hereby ordered that Z.C. Case No. 92-9 be authorized for public hearing. A formal "Notice of Public Hearing" is forthcoming.
