PUBLIC HEARING--Sept. 30, 1964

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried the following Order was entered on October 7, 1964:

ORDERED:

That the appeal for permission to erect apt. bldg. with roof structures in accordance with the provisions of Section 3308 of the Zoning Regulations at 2127-31 L St. N.W., lots 43, 71 and 72, square 72, be granted for the following reasons:

(1) From the records and the evidence adduced at the hearing, the Board finds that the enclosure on the roof of this proposed apartment building for service equipment will harmonize with the main structure in architectural character, material and color.

(2) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the public hearing.
