PUBLIC HEARING--October 21, 1964

Appeal #7961 G. M. P. Corp. owner, on behalf of Republic of South Africa, appellant.
The Zoning Administrator District of Columbia, appellee.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried the following Order was entered on October 27, 1964:

ORDERED:

That the appeal to permit continued occupancy of premises as a chancery for a temporary period until the end of February 1965, at 3700 Massachusetts Ave. N.W., lot 12, square 1929, be granted for the following reasons:

(1) Under date of October 29, 1963, appeal #7487 this Board granted the appellant permission to use these premises for a temporary period of one year only while their Embassy was in the process of being renovated and after which the chancery intended to move back to its own quarters. Appellant now advises the Board that the tentative date of moving will be in December and therefore asks for this extension of time.

(2) All of the facts and opinion in appeal #7487 are incorporated into this order by reference.

(3) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the public hearing.
