

PUBLIC HEARING—November 25, 1964

Appeal #7993 Geo. A. Lehmann, Marie Louise Lehman Kealy and Walter J. Kealy,
appellants.

The Zoning Administrator District of Columbia, appellee.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried the following Order
was entered on December 1, 1964:

ORDERED:

That the appeal to erect apartment building with roof structures in
accordance with Section 3308 of the Zoning Regulations at 1823 L St. N.W., lot
807, square 140, be granted for the following reasons:

(1) From the records and the evidence adduced at the hearing, the Board
finds that the enclosure on the roof of this proposed apartment building for
service equipment will harmonize with the main structure in architectural
character, material and color.

(2) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the
public hearing.
