PUBLIC HEARING--June 16, 1965

Appeal #8221 Georgetown Day School, Inc. appellant.

The Zoning Administrator District of Columbia, appellee.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried the following Order was entered on June 22, 1965:

ORDERED:

That the appeal to establish a private school for retarded children at 5005 MacArthur Boulevard, N.W., lots 826, 827 and 828, square 1410, be granted for the following reasons:

(1) This Board on December 18, 1963, in appeal #7540 granted this identical appeal. Due to failure to secure necessary permits within the six month period as required by the Zoning Regulations appellant was required to refile.

(2) Inasmuch as conditions have not materially altered since the approval in appeal # 7540 the Board adopts the finding of facts and opinion in that appeal and again grants the appeal.

(3) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the public hearing.
