

PUBLIC HEARING—June 16, 1965

Appeal #8229 Associated Limited Partnership, appellant.

The Zoning Administrator District of Columbia, appellee.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried the following Order was entered on July 14, 1965:

ORDERED:

That the appeal to erect apartment building with roof structures in accordance with Section 3308 of the Zoning Regulations at 2716 Wisconsin Avenue, N. W., lots 36 and 37, square 37, as amended<sup>e</sup> to include a driveway less than that in width as required by the Zoning Regulations, be granted.

(1) From the records and the evidence adduced at the hearing, the Board finds that the enclosure on the roof of this proposed apartment building for service equipment will harmonize with the main structure in architectural character, material and color.

(2) The Board further finds that due to the design of the building that the provisions of driveway into the parking area less than that required by the regulations is justified and will provide adequate ingress and egress to the parking area.

(3) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the public hearing.
