

PUBLIC HEARING--Sept. 22, 1965

Appeal #8346 The National Assn. of Life Underwriters, appellant.

The Zoning Administrator District of Columbia, appellee.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried the following Order was entered on September 28, 1965:

ORDERED:

That the appeal to erect an addition to its non-profit organization headquarters located in the SP District and to erect roof structures in accordance with Section 3308 of the Zoning Regulations at 1922 F St. N.W., lot 827, square 122, be granted for the following reasons:

- (1) The Board is of the opinion that the erection of this addition to this non-profit organization headquarters building will be in harmony with existing uses on neighboring or adjacent property and will not create dangerous or other objectionable traffic conditions.
- (2) The Department of Highways and Traffic reports that it is not anticipated that the existence of this large building will create any undue traffic congestion on either 20th or F Streets.
- (3) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the public hearing.
