PUBLIC HEARING -- January 12, 1966

Appeal No. 8551 George Washington University, appellant.

The Zoning Administrator District of Columbia, appellee.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the following Order was entered on January 18, 1966:

DATE OF THE ORDER -- February 10, 1966

ORDERED:

That the appeal to erect two additional new air handling units to roof structures in accordance with Section 3308 of the Zoning Regulations at 901 23rd Street, NW., lot 828, Square 54, be granted for the following reasons:

(1) From the records and the evidence adduced at the hearing, the Board finds that the enclosure on the roof of this hospital building, for service equipment will harmonize with the main structure in architectural character, material and color.

(2) The Board notes that roof structures were previously approved in Appeal No. 7678 dated June 2, 1964.

(3) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the public hearing.
