
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On October 6, 2000, the Office of Zoning received from the Office of Planning a recommendation to amend the text of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulation Title 11 DCMR Zoning. The purpose of the proposed amendments was to provide regulations that further define and guide the development of antenna towers in the District of Columbia.

On February 5, 2001, at the time of the scheduled hearing, the Zoning Commission recognized the need for greater information surrounding this case. It was agreed that, given the complexity of the subject, what had been proposed and advertised did not fully cover the subject matter. In particular, the Commission determined that a Public Roundtable would be a preferred forum to fully cover the matter. The issue of standards for antenna towers in the District of Columbia needs more research prior to submittal of proposed amendments.

Upon consideration of the reasons set forth herein, the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia, by consensus and pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3011.3, hereby DISMISSES Z.C. Case No. 00-29TA.

In accordance with 11 DCMR § 3028, this order is final and effective upon publication in the DC Register; that is on MAR 23 2001.
